Parking

Southampton General Hospital has a main multistorey car park (car park 1) and disabled car parking in car parks 2 and 7. Car parking charges apply but discounts (from £11 to £7) can be obtained for visitors - please bring your ticket to Travelwise to avail the discount. There are drop-off and collection points around the site and free facilities for motorbikes and cycles.

At peak times parking will be limited, **so please allow extra time before the event to park**, and also ensure that you only park within the designated areas.

Overnight Hotel Accommodation

The venue does not host overnight accommodation. However being in the heart of Southampton there are plenty of hotels around. Recommended websites to use when looking for a hotel would be www.tripadvisor.co.uk, www.expedia.co.uk or www.trivago.co.uk. All these websites offer great deals and prices on all Southampton hotels.

Location and Transport

There are good transport links to and from the hospital. You can catch a bus from outside the main entrance on Tremona Road. Routes and times are available from the Information Point at the main entrance, where there is also a real time data board detailing actual bus arrival and departure times. There is also a taxi rank outside the main entrance, and a free taxi phone in the corridor just inside the main entrance. The nearest mainline train station is Southampton Central. Close to shops, theatres, restaurants and the University of Southampton.

The nearest airport to the venue is Southampton airport. Taxi from Isle of Wight ferry terminal at Southampton docks, or by bus: Catch the free green "City Link" bus from outside the Hythe ferry terminal entrance to the train station. From the opposite side of the train line, catch the number 3 bus direct to Southampton General Hospital.
