Research Fellowship Application Form

Purpose

The British Cardiovascular Society offers Fellowships to support research training in either clinical or basic science in cardiovascular medicine in an institute of the applicants' choice. These Fellowships are intended for doctors training for a career in cardiovascular medicine who are at an early stage in their research and may be held in the United Kingdom or abroad. The Fellowships are open to all trainees including those who have already obtained a higher degree.

Description

The British Cardiovascular Society invites applications for a BCS/Bristol Myers Squibb Prize Fellowship which will be funded for up to three years with an allowance of up to £15,000 for consumables per annum (subject to satisfactory annual review). Two additional research Fellowships will also be funded for up to two years, following review, and include a small allowance towards consumables. The successful candidate's current salary will be maintained, and allowances will be paid for project, travel and relocation expenses to a maximum total of £5000. No further expenses, beyond the original £5000, are available for a project extension. Full economic costing contribution will not be paid.

The Fellowship should normally be taken up within 6 months of the offer and delay beyond this will be at the discretion of the Academic and Research Committee. The Society wishes these Fellowships to be as flexible as possible.

Application

Candidates should complete the application form, which includes an outline of the research project, and submit it together with their curriculum vitae, a letter of recommendation from the proposed supervisor of the research project, and a letter of support from their current head of department or similar sponsor. Applicants should not submit any additional documentation. Nothing other than the requested information will be sent to those reviewing the applications. Any overseas applicants are requested to indicate their links with British Cardiology.

Selection

The British Cardiovascular Society Academic and Research Committee will review the applications and a shortlist of candidates will be established. Interviews will likely take place in March 2007 at the British Cardiovascular Society offices. All candidates will be notified of the result within a week following the interview and the successful candidate will be asked to confirm in writing, within ten days, their acceptance of the Fellowship.

- 5) Protocol of investigation
- 6) Expenses specific to this research

The total (excluding references) should not exceed four sides of A4 of which approximately two sides should be hypothesis and protocol investigation. 12pt is the smallest acceptable font size.
