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I am a full time NHS Consultant, working as the lead clinician in an internationally renowned busy tertiary centre for fetal cardiology and am regarded a leading expert in the field of fetal cardiology. I am married with two children and have had to balance family and work commitments.

My job involves the diagnosis and management of prenatal congenital heart disease including fetal arrhythmias. We make 150- 200 new cardiac diagnoses in fetal life in the unit each year. We have developed a one-stop service model that allows seamless care for mother and baby following a diagnosis of a fetal heart problem. As well as focusing on making an accurate ultrasound diagnosis and providing up to date information regarding management and outcomes of conditions, there is a strong focus on providing support for parents following the diagnosis of a problem.

I have published widely in the field of fetal cardiology and my publications to date have provided the evidence base for the guidance we give to families and the subsequent management decisions. I have given many invited talks at international meetings and have been active in both organising and teaching in courses and symposia

I am the lead educational supervisor for paediatric cardiology trainees in our trust and act as a clinical advisor for medical students. I am a member of the London Deanery STC and the Royal College SAC for paediatric cardiology. I also am a member of the education committee of the Association of European paediatric Cardiologists (AEPC).
